- I. **Meeting** was called to order at 6:30 p.m. by President Christina Bergman.
- II. **Minutes:** The November 17, 2009 meeting minutes were read. Motion to approve minutes was made by Christina Bergman: seconded by Stacey Krastins. Minutes were approved.
- III. **Green Team Report (Carlin Bylsma & Julie Lown):** The Kick Off Assembly will be on January 29th and Miranda from WOOD TV 8 and the Green Guys will be attending. The assembly will launch the “Green Challenge” which is designed to help make students and their families more aware of how to be green at home everyday.
