Class Registration

Enrollment for the Winter 2010 Rosy Mound Enrichment Program will be done through mail-in registration ONLY. **Registration forms and payments will be accepted until January 19th at 4:00pm.**

Limited Enrollment:

Although there is no limit to the enrichment experiences that your child can enjoy, class sizes are limited. The only students eligible for guaranteed enrollment into the class of their choice are children of enrichment class instructors.

If enrollment for any class exceeds the allotted spaces, the forms collected before the registration deadline will be entered into a “lottery” system and names will be randomly drawn until the class is full.

The lottery will take place at the conclusion of the scheduled PTA meeting on January 19th at 6:30pm in the Media Center. If a class is filled during the lottery and your child is not admitted into the class, the enrollment form and payment will be promptly returned to you.

Due to the popularity of this program, NO waiting lists will be kept and all classes will be held to the maximum enrollment size listed in this brochure.

Payment Information:

Each class requires it's own registration form and payment (Cash or Check only). Additional registration forms are available at www.rosypta.org. If forms do not have the payment attached, they will be ineligible for the “lottery” should it occur for the class in which you are enrolling your child in.

Make checks payable to: ROSY MOUND PTA.

For example: If you are enrolling your child in 2 classes, you will write 2 checks. If you are enrolling 2 children in the same class, you will still be writing 2 checks. Writing separate checks aids in prompt refunds if a class gets cancelled due to low enrollment or if your child is not admitted into the class during the lottery should it occur.

CASH payments will be handed by the enrichment committee and a receipt will be sent home.

A \$15 fee will be assessed to any returned check and the student will be un-enrolled in the class unless a cash payment is made within 2 business days.

Refunds are unavailable unless the class is cancelled due to low enrollment. If classes

Notifying Regular Classroom Teachers:

To reduce the risk of you child being sent home on the bus on Enrichment Class Day, it is your responsibility to send a reminder note to your child's regular classroom teacher on each day of enrichment classes.

Class Times:

All Classes are held at Rosy Mound Elementary from 4pm to 5pm in designated classrooms unless otherwise specified. Parents should pick their child up from their enrichment classrooms.

Instructors have the discretion to dismiss a student that is not being picked up promptly or a student who is disrupting the class.

After-school Snack:

To help keep class costs down, we are asking that a nutritious and “peanut-free” snack be sent to school with your child for them to eat before entering the enrichment classroom.
