The PTA sponsors many events that benefit our school, students, families, and faculty. We are in need of many volunteers who are willing to contribute their time and talents to help make this year's events possible.

National Walk to School Day – October 9

This is an opportunity for students to join the rest of our nation's schools and be a part of Michigan's Safe Routes to School. Students are encouraged to form their own groups and walk to school on this day.

Holiday Pancake Breakfast – Saturday December 7th

'Tis the Season to celebrate the season with staff, friends, and other Rosy Mound families! This event takes many volunteers and includes pancake breakfast, kid crafts, and pictures with Santa!

Holiday Craft show– Saturday December 7th

This craft show runs during the Holiday breakfast. Why not get some shopping done while eating pancakes and visiting Santa? Volunteers need to help get artisans, advertise, or set up and take down tables on the day of the event.

Scholastic Book Fair Saturday Dec 7th

An opportunity for students to purchase gifts and books just before Christmas. Every dollar spent on books, our school receives fifty cents for book purchases for our school library and/or classrooms.

Pink Out February 14th

Our "Pink Out" event is to raise awareness and funds to help find a cure for cancer, while having fun! Students who wear PINK will get one stripe of pink hair coloring. Students can get an additional stripe for \$1 apiece for up to a \$5 donation. Our goal is to have the whole school participate causing a PINK OUT!

Jog-a-thon 2014– May 2nd
